There will be oral presentations and an hour long poster session. In addition posters will be displayed for the entire meeting. Four submitted abstracts will be chosen for short ten minute talks. Abstracts that pertain to research projects that encompass this year’s theme will be given priority in the determination of oral presentation. We encourage all students, fellows, research technicians, junior faculty and others to present their work as one important purpose of this meeting is to foster an exchange of ideas and to meet new colleagues.

Please note the following:

1. On line registration will open January 2, 2012 and will remain be open until March 2, 2012. The registration fee is \$10 for students, technicians and fellow and \$25 for faculty.
2. Pre-registration and abstract submission must be made electronically. This year registration fees will be paid on line only. Registration forms including fee payment are available on TCRB website.
3. We encourage EVERYONE to try and present a poster as these presentations are an essential aspect of the TCRB meeting. Deadline for abstract submission is January 9’ 2012. Poster titles and authors will be listed on our website by February 10, 2012.
4. We encourage attendees to meet the vendors and to that end there will be designated times to meet them in Vendor Fairs.
