A 300 word single-spaced abstract should be submitted to Phyllis Leppert, MD, PhD by email on or before midnight January 9, 2012. Please email the abstract to phyllis.leppert@duke.edu We ask that you please indicate if you would like the abstract to be a poster only, or to be considered for a short oral presentation. Presentations not selected by the committee for oral presentation will be presented as a posters.

All topics relevant to reproductive biology may be submitted, This includes male and female reproductive tract anatomy , function, and diseases of the reproductive tract in humans and animals, gametogenesis, reproductive hormone signaling and secretion, animal and cell models of physiology and disease, gestation and parturition, environmental impact on reproduction, epidemiology of reproduction and reproductive disease, implantation, fertility and infertility, as well as reproductive tract development and the genetics of reproduction. Out theme for 2012 is Reproductive Tract Organogenesis.

We encourage all participants to submit abstracts. For this meeting we will choose four abstracts for a short 10 minute oral presentation followed by a 5 minute discussion. Preference will be given to abstracts pertaining to Organogenesis. However, all abstracts submitted will considered for poster presentation.

The Program Committee will make the selections for oral presentations. All those who submit abstracts will be notified of their selection status by February 9th 2012 and the poster and oral presentations will be posted on the TCRB website by February 10, 2012. Members of the committee are:
